

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

(9/28/2009)

The Director of the Nebraska Department of Correctional Services has scheduled a public hearing as required by Neb.Rev.Stat. §84-909 for the proposed adoption of Title 69, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 11, Execution Protocol. The purpose of the proposed regulation is to establish a protocol for the implementation of L.B. 36 (2009). There will be a minimal fiscal impact on the Department of Correctional Services for supplies and equipment associated with the protocol and the costs will be absorbed by the current budget. There will be no fiscal impact on political subdivisions or the public. There will be no fiscal impact. A copy of the fiscal impact statement is available at the Nebraska Department of Correctional Services and through the Department's website at www.corrections.state.ne.us.

All persons interested in presenting oral or written views on the proposed adoption of Chapter 11 will be granted an opportunity at a hearing before the Nebraska Department of Correctional Services to be held beginning at 9:00 a.m. on the 16th day of November, 2009. The hearing will continue until concluded. Said hearing will be held in the in Conference Room F on the lower level of the State Office Building located at 501 South 14th Street, Lincoln, NE.

Interested persons may submit written comments to the Department of Correctional Services before the hearing date. The written comments will be entered into the record. The hearing will be transcribed at the request of any party with the expense of the transcription charged to the requesting party.
