

Notice of Public Hearing


The Nebraska Department of Correctional Services (NDCS) will hold a rule-making hearing pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §84-807 at 9 am on the 24th day of June, 2016 to be held at the NDCS Central Office located at 801 W. Prospector Place, Building 1, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509.

The purpose of the hearing is to take testimony and evidence about the adoption of Title 72, Chapter 2, entitled Procedures for Declaratory Orders, Contested Cases and Rulemaking Petitions. This action is proposed to implement Neb. Rev. Stat. §84-909 consistent with the authority granted by law and with constitutionality.

The subject matter and scope of the rule-making action is the process for declaratory orders, rulemaking petitions and contested cases under the Administrative Procedure Act. The rules set out the filing requirements, hearing process, a timeframe for agency response, the information that must be provided by the agency, and other procedural requirements for requesting declaratory orders, filing rulemaking petitions and contested cases.

Draft or working copies of the proposed rules are available at the offices of the Secretary of State, Regulations Division, Room 343, State Capitol, Lincoln, NE 68509. There is no expected fiscal impact from adopting these regulations.

All interested persons are invited to attend and testify orally or by written submission at the hearing. Interested persons may also submit written comments prior to the hearing which will be made part of the hearing record if received by NDCS on or before June 20, 2016.
