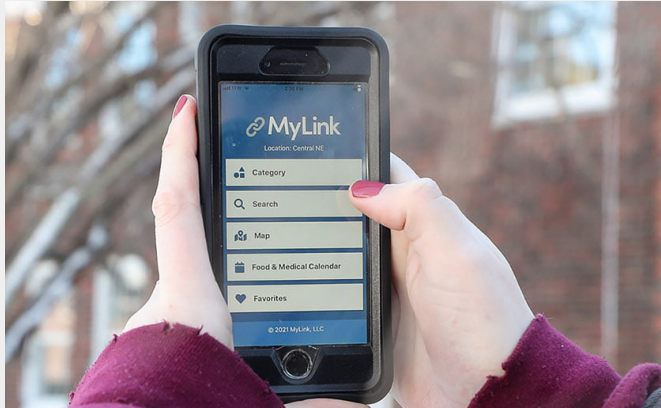
## NEW RESOURCES

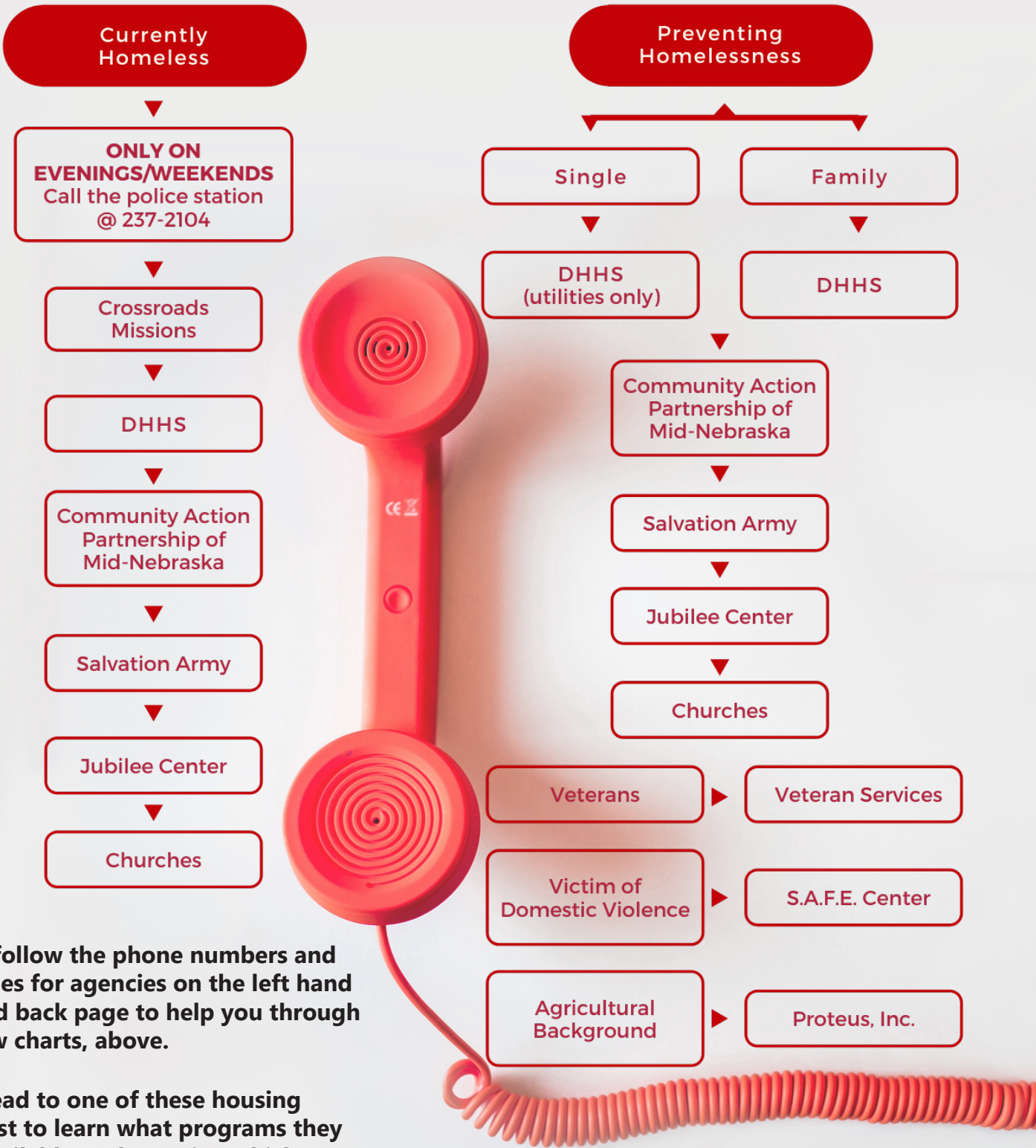
