## Do you want to become a United State Citizen?

The Center for people in Need offers free legal assistance to complete the application for Naturalization AND offers free Citizenship preparation classes to help applicants pass the Naturalization interview and the Civic Exam. Next session begins March 2015.

### To be eligible:

- ⇒You must be 18 years of age or older
- ⇒You must have been a legal permanent resident for 5 years (3 years if you married to U.S citizen)
- ⇒You must be able to meet the minimum English language requirement to complete the Naturalization interview and the Civic exam (Note: there are a few exemptions to this—we can help determine if you meet one of the exemptions)
- ⇒You must be a person of good moral Character
- ⇒You must have a household income at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty level.

## Benefits of Being a U.S Citizen

- · Right to vote
- \* Eligible to apply for federal jobs
- \* Travel with a U.S Passport
- \* Priority and wider eligibility in qualification your relatives for immigration benefits
