Housing & Support Services

InResponse Rapid Rehousing

InResponse helps individuals and families who have experienced a housing crisis quickly regain stability by offering rent and utility assistance, case management, and employment support services.

Individuals and families must be staying at a shelter, on the streets, or fleeing domestic violence to qualify.

A housing assessment is required in order to apply for assistance. Please call Family Service Lincoln at 402-904-5572 to complete this assessment.

Youth Homeless Demonstration Program (YHDP)

Through YHDP, we offer a Rapid Rehousing program and a Permanent Supportive Housing program to help youth obtain stable housing.

Youth ages 18-24 who are unhoused or fleeing domestic violence are eligible for assistance.

A housing assessment is required in order to apply for assistance. Please call Family Service Lincoln at 402-904-5572 to complete this assessment.
