ACADEMIC SUCCESS

- Use your syllabus to stay on top of assignments and due dates. You won't get reminders!

- Take good notes. Use apps like Evernote, Dropbox and Asana.
- **Keep up with your reading.** Read a bit each day so you can enjoy some free time.
- Meet with your professors if you don't understand a concept or assignment.

MAKING A MAJOR DECISION

- Seek help from the career center and your advisor if you're unsure about your major.
- Along with core requirements, take electives that are in your potential major.
- Join student organizations that relate to potential careers. This will help you discover if the fit is right.

MONEY MATTERS

- **Set a budget and stick to it.** Be especially careful with eating out the cost adds up quickly.
- Complete the <u>FAFSA</u> every year you're in college to continue receiving financial aid including student loans.
- **Keep looking for scholarships.** Resources include the financial aid office and free Internet sites.
- Borrow only what you need in student loans. Use loans only for tuition, housing, books and fees.
- Estimate future student loan payments so you'll be prepared. Keep track of your loans at NSLDS.ed.gov.
