
Over 40,000 Iraq and Afghanistan Veterans have been treated at a VA hospital for substance abuse.

Our Program

The programs are structured to address a Veteran's needs no matter their level of readiness. Information is specifically designed to allow Veterans and soldiers the opportunity to gain insight into their use of substances.

There are various levels of care available at each of the three sites. Staff utilize the American Society of Addiction Medicine Placement Criteria, the DSM-IV Diagnostic Criteria for Dependence and Stages of Change in our intake interviews to determine appropriate level of care.

Each program provides individual/ group therapy, education, and pharmacological interventions, when appropriate.

Each program is staffed by a wide variety of health care providers that include psychiatrist, physicians, social work, and nursing staff.
