RE: Additions to OM 205.02.01 Inmate Visiting Section XXI Visitor Dress Code

1. Shirts will not be permitted if they come below two inches from the bottom of the neck. If the neck of the shirt has to be pulled up to meet this requirement it will not be permitted.
2. Undershirts must be tucked in. If the visitor is not wearing an undershirt, the outer shirt must be tucked in. Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in and remain tucked in while raising arms and bending over.
3. V- neck tops will not be permitted unless there is another top underneath the V neck. The undershirt must be no lower than 2 inches below the neck (10 years or under are excluded)
4. Coats, jackets of any kind, sweaters, sweatshirts, hooded shirts, cardigans and outerwear are not permitted in the visiting room. This includes fleece jackets. The exceptions are blazer or suit jacket. Shirts/sweaters with drawstrings or oversized necks will not be allowed.
5. Visitors will not be permitted to wear multiple layers of clothing (No more than an undershirt and one shirt).
6. With the exception of persons conducting official business or in military uniform; visitors will not be permitted to wear any type of uniform such as medical, other state agency uniforms, UPS, Postal etc.
7. Children who are old enough to walk are required to wear shoes. Shoes are to remain on at all times.
8. Visitors are only allowed to wear the following jewelry: 1 ring (wedding set included); 1 pair of earrings (or 2 facial piercings); 1 watch (smart or multi-functional watches are not allowed); one necklace, 1 religious medallion and 1 med alert jewelry item. No bracelets of any kind are permitted.
